The training includes graduation from MCM DAV College Sector 36, Chandigarh, Preparation for AFCAT/ CDSE written examination and personality development to clear SSB interview, to seek admission into Officers Training Academy (OTA), Chennai and Air Force Academy (AFA), Dundigal. The Institute provides lifetime golden opportunity for girls to prepare themselves for their future life. The institute is named after Saint Warrior Mai Bhago Ji and is laid out on a sprawling 8.5 acres, beautifully landscaped area in Sector 66, Mohali. The institute started functioning from July 2015 with 25 Lady Cadets and the first batch passed out in July 2018. Every year 25 lady Cadets are selected in Jul/Aug for the new batch.



- Age should be 16 years or more, as on 1st July of the year of admission. Minimum Height should be 153 cm and weight 40.5 to 42 Kgs, besides meeting the medical standards for the Defence Services.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE


- Online Application based on dates advertised in newspapers (Generally in March/April).
- Entrance test of 120 questions in General English, Science, Maths, Social Studies and General Awareness. (Previous Years Questions/Sample papers are available on website).
- Candidates (as per cut off decided) go through Interview and Physical Fitness Test.
- Further shortlisted candidates go through Medical Examination.
- Top 25 candidates in the order of merit join the Institute.
